


ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY #16

RE: Underground Electrical Service

1. WHEREAS the Town of Seekonk in conjunction with the Mass. Dept. of Public Works has decided to rebuild a Town Way, Oak Hill Avenue and
2. WHEREAS the homes existing along said way are established and serviced by water, gas, telephone, electric and cable television etc. and
3. WHEREAS some of the homes along Oak Hill Avenue have underground electrical services that must be moved onto newly relocated poles and
4. WHEREAS the Mass. Electric Co. has an established policy whereby a licensed electrician must install the underground service from a predetermined height on their pole to the house being served at the home owners expense and
5. WHEREAS the Board of Selectmen feel that the home owners along Oak Hill Avenue, having been inconvenienced enough by the rebuilding of said roadway, and should not have to suffer expensed over which they have no control.
6. THEREFORE be it resolved that the Town of Seekonk will reimburse the home owner for expenses incurred by this relocation of underground electrical service.
