

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY #20

RE: Street Lighting

1. A moratorium on new lights was adopted in 1973.
2. Requests for street lights will be reviewed by the Police Chief and Superintendent of Public Works.

They will take into account the number of cars and pedestrians using the area, curves in the road and intersections. Street lighting is for public traffic safety, not to replace private security lighting.

They will then send their recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.

3. No new lights will be installed without the express vote of the Board of Selectmen.
