

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY #21

RE: Transient Vendor Licenses.

1. If the applicant is registered as a corporation in Massachusetts he may apply for a Hawker & Peddler's License at the Seekonk Town Hall by filling out the appropriate application. Such application shall be filed at least 10 days before the Selectmen's meeting at which the license is to be granted. The fee, if approved, will be determined by the Board of Selectmen.
2. If an applicant is not registered in the Commonwealth, he must obtain a permit from the Division of Standards, Room 1115 John McCormack Building, Boston, Massachusetts:
 - A. Applicants must appear or write to the above mentioned state agency for an application to conduct these sales.
 - B. When the application is completed, it must be accompanied by a \$500.00 certified check, bond or cash.
 - C. Presentation of this permit to the Seekonk Licensing Authority is required showing that it has been approved by the Massachusetts Division of Standards (this permit is for one year.)

If approved, a Transient Vendor's license will be issued by the Board of Selectmen; fee to be determined by them.
 - D. The Division of Standards does not set any hours as to the operation of these events including Sundays. However, the Sunday laws, concerning such events, must still be observed.
