## Signage Relative to Vehicle Traffic

### PURPOSE:

Under Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 90, Section 19, the Board of Selectmen have broad authority to regulate traffic on local roads.


### POLICY:


Before such regulations are legally enforceable, the following steps must be taken:

1. A legal advertisement must be published in one or more newspapers in Town,
2. Where applicable, approval must be obtained by the Massachusetts Highway Department as being consistent with the public interest, and,
3. The public must be properly notified that the traffic signs will be posted.
