Please publish the following in the Evening Bulletin of March 20, 1984:

### CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

This is to announce the continuation of the Public Hearing for Heritage Homes of Attleboro, Inc., 830 Lindsey Street, Attleboro, Ma. which was last in session on May 23, 1983.

The continuation is scheduled for 8:30 P.M. on Monday, March 26, 1984, at the Seekonk Town Hall, 100 Peck Street, Seekonk, MA

The purpose of the proposed project is to revise and reshape approximately 1100 feet of existing stream bed known as Clear Run Brook starting adjacent to the outlet of the 30" pipe (Invert 30.65) at Miller Street to approximate elevation 27.00. They propose to reshape the existing bed of the brook by cleaning out the excessive siltation and reshaping the banks of the stream by use of rip-rap so as to cause the free flow of water through the existing stream in the area of the proposed lots 16A, 1A, 3A, 11A, 10A, 15A, 13A, 12A, and 69, as shown on plan entitled "Heritage Heights - Definitive Topographical Plan - January 17, 1980."
