

## **C. Project Description**

### **1. b. Area Description**

This area is a residential lot of 27,462 square feet and is the last lot on the south side of John Alden Road. Improvements on the lot include a 27 x 48 foot raised ranch, a 23 x 48 foot paved driveway, and an 8 x 8 foot shed. Other than for these improvements, the entire lot is in grass with various trees, shrubs, and flowers. The lot is bordered on the east side by WS 1 wetlands.

### **2. a. Work Description**

This project entails removing two diseased and damaged trees so as to preclude their causing harm to people or structures on this lot or neighboring property. One tree is a poplar with a circumference of 55 inches at the ground and is approximately 75 to 80 feet tall. It appears to be diseased from the ground to a height of 10 feet and is cracked at the base. At its closest point it is 71 feet from the house and is leaning toward it at an angle of approximately 82 degrees. It is 54 feet from the east property line ( wetlands ). The other tree is a large cherry tree with three trunks coming out of the ground. Two of those trunks are obviously dead, the largest of which overhangs the neighboring property. The third trunk has a circumference of 80 inches at the ground and splits into three branches after about six feet of growth. There are numerous dead and rotten limbs on these three branches. This cherry tree is approximately 70 feet tall and directly overhangs a shed on the property. It is 26 feet from the east property line ( wetlands ). Both of these trees will be cut at the ground and all wood and debris will be hauled away. There will be no stump grinding and there will be no workmen or equipment in the wetlands.
