

b. Area Description (use additional paper, if necessary):

The proposed location for the Site A anomaly repair occurs along Ledge Road south of Greenwood Avenue, north of Hope Street, and west of Jacob Street. The work area is located within a lawn of a residence located adjacent to a perennial stream south of Ledge Road.

The proposed location for the Site B anomaly repair occurs within a fairway associated with the Ledgesmont Country Club, and is located within the buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland (BVW).

The proposed location for the Site C anomaly repair occurs adjacent to Cedar Hill Terrace, located south of Pine Street and east of Brown Avenue. It is located within a maintained right of way (ROW) adjacent to a cul-de-sac within the buffer zone to a BVW.

2. a. Work Description (use additional paper and/or provide plan(s) of work, if necessary):

Mobil Pipe Line Company (Mobil) discovered three anomalies within its steel pipeline in the Town of Seekonk during routine line testing/renovation and proposes to repair/replace them. The anomalies occur within existing disturbed, maintained right-of-way (Row) adjacent to Ledge Road and Cedar Hill Terrace, and under a fairway associated with the Ledgesmont Country Club. The contractor/Mobil will verify the location of the excavation sites and check all field measurements and construction staking prior to the commencement of construction. Minimal site work is proposed for each of the three sites and will include the excavation of 10-foot x 10-foot area in order to inspect and potentially remove the faulty section of pipeline, and to allow for the safe access of personnel. The overall work area will be approximately 20 feet by 60 feet in order to accommodate the equipment necessary to replace the pipeline as well as to include excavation spoils that will be placed within close proximity to the work site in a controlled area. Stormwater encountered during excavation will be pumped from the sites and discharged to outlying areas where it will be filtered through hay bales to maintain water quality. Erosion and sedimentation controls in the form of staked hay bales will be implemented on-site in order to prevent alteration of the surrounding resource areas.
