



TOWN OF SEEKONK CHECKLIST FOR DECKS

- Two copies of a construction drawing of the deck itself showing the dimensions, materials, floor plan, framing plans for floors, roof (if any) and generally showing its construction.
- Certified Plot Plan showing proposed deck and zoning setbacks. Please ask us to look up your zone if you don't know what it is.
- Board of Health setbacks to your septic system & leaching field need to be shown on plot plan. *(Board of Health signoff is needed PRIOR to receiving your building permit, this sheet can be found at the Building Department at the time of applying for permit).*
- The Conservation Sign off is required. *(Conservation sign off is needed PRIOR to receiving your building permit, this sheet can be found at the Building Department at the time of applying for permit).*
- A completed Residential Building application & Workers' Comp. Insurance affidavit. If you are a homeowner doing the work yourself; you can apply for the building permit as homeowner. If hiring a contractor; the contractor must be the one to apply for the permit.
