Discussion	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Joe has not yet received a reply from the Seekonk High School principal regarding promoting the Memorial Day parade on their message board. He will follow up by calling him directly.2. Jim reported that the message board in front of the senior center will start promoting the parade after the town meeting on May 12th.3. Kathy had one confirmation not previously reported for the parade – antique fire trucks.4. Jim let Bill George know that the Veterans Council would not be riding on the Seekonk Fire Museum’s antique fire truck.5. Kevin reported that the CERT team will have a pickup truck as well as personnel walking the parade route. They will not have a trailer as previously forecasted.6. Kathy ran down the parade order of all the confirmed parade participants. She will continue to send out updates as we receive further confirmations.7. Jim received word from Matt Bosh that there are no other scheduled events on the morning of the parade. He said that spring sports team could add a practice, but that would entail a minimum of extra vehicle traffic in the parking lot.
