- Offer signups for a low-cost dental program (for low-income seniors)

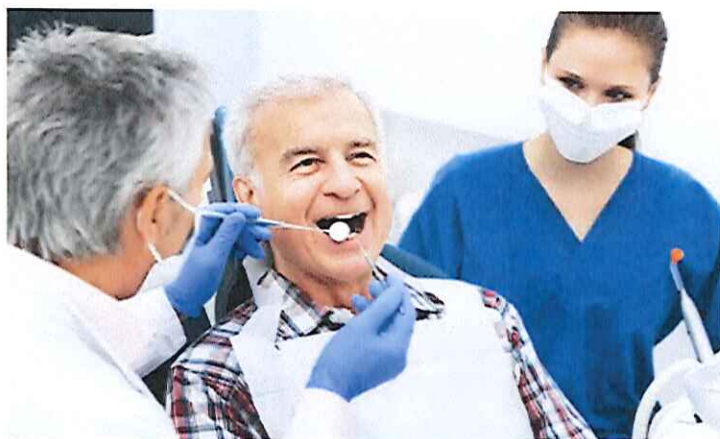
The Clinic is open to anyone aged 60 years and older, living in Massachusetts.
