Yard waste including grass clippings, leaves, brush & branches up to 1.5inch diameter and no longer than 3ft are accepted without a pass. Finished compost is available free of charge and can be picked up at TARF during opening hours.

Bulky items are accepted at TARF on Bulky Waste Days only, and a pass is required. Passes must be purchased at DPW 871 Taunton Ave \$29 for one visit \$87 for three visits

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

When a collection day falls on one of the following holidays, pickup will be delayed one day-including Friday pickup moved to Saturday: **New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr Day, President's Day, Patriot's Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.**

- All Batteries, Cell Phones, Ink/Toner, Mercury Thermostats & Fluorescent Bulbs are accepted at DPW or stores
- Plastic bags & film (stretchy wrap) should be returned to store collection
- Latex paint can be left open to dry, then placed in your blue bag trash
- Old eyeglasses (no cases) are accepted in DPW lobby
- Clothing/linens (in any condition as long as dry) can be placed in the textile collection bins at DPW & schools
- Terracycle collection shed at DPW for hundreds of everyday items
- String Lights & Extension cords are accepted at DPW (never in your bin!)
- Fire Extinguishers are accepted at the Fire Dept for disposal

Curbside Recycling Pickup

- ✓ Glass bottles & jars, all colors
- ✓ Plastic **CONTAINERS**: jars/jugs/bottles/cups
- ✓ Aluminum/tin/steel cans
- ✓ Aluminum foil/pie plates
- ✓ Newspapers/magazines/junk mail
- ✓ Office paper/paper bags/envelopes
- ✓ Paperboard (cereal boxes, egg carton)
- ✓ Cardboard-flatten/cut to less than 2'x2'
- ✓ Pizza boxes (grease is fine, remove liners)

NOT ALLOWED IN RECYCLING BIN:

Food/Liquids Textiles Hoses Hangers
Plastic Bags Haz Waste Paint/Paint Cans
Broken Glass Light Bulbs **Black Plastic**
Styrofoam Pipes Batteries Tires Dishes
Cords Electronics Toys **Shredded Paper**
Napkins/Paper Towels Nips RX Bottles
Straws Misc Trash/Rubbish/Garbage

*If not listed in ✓**GREEN**✓above, it shouldn't
go in your Recycling Bin-place in trash or
check for special handling.*

When in doubt-KEEP IT OUT!

Curbside Bulky Waste & Yard Waste Pickup

Stickers for curbside pickup can be purchased at DPW (*cash or check only*) for the following:

Large Appliances/AC/Dehumidifier \$16.00
(monthly pickup 3rd Tues)

**Furniture, toilet/sink, carpet, tires (no rims)
& other items that cannot fit in a blue bag**
\$8.50 (bi-monthly pickup 2nd and 4th Weds)

Electronics, metal & small appliances \$8.50
(monthly pickup 3rd Tues)

Mattresses & Boxsprings \$65 each includes a bag for protection (monthly pickup 3rd Wed)

Christmas Trees (no fee) Remove tinsel & ornaments (pickup throughout January)

Yard Waste (no fee) Leaves, grass, brush in PAPER BAGS & branches up to 1.5inch diameter/under 3ft in bundles. Max 30lbs each Limit 25 bags/bundles. **Pickup** offered during May, Oct (starting the week after Columbus Day) & Nov -put out on normal trash day.

Drop-off is open year-round at TARF.

Curbside Trash Pickup

All trash must be in Seekonk blue bags & all bags must be tied!

Trash must be in bin to be collected. Place bins curbside by 7:00AM 2ft away from other bins, mailboxes or any obstructions.
