

The Massachusetts Board of Examiners of Sheet Metal Workers Policy # 2010-01 Regarding Work Not Requiring a Permit – *Minor Alterations*.

The following policy has been adopted to reduce the cost and time associated with sheet metal permitting and inspections on residential furnace and air handler replacements.

Effective April 12, 2010 the following work associated with the change-out of residential furnaces and air handlers will not require a sheet metal permit:

- New supply air transition from new furnace / air handler to existing supply air plenum
- New return air filter rack and transition from new furnace / air handler to existing return air plenum

The Board reserves the right to revise, alter, amend or eliminate this policy at anytime without notice.

* Please note the above policy does NOT eliminate the need for a sheet metal license
