MassDevelopment Technical Assistance Grant

The Town of Seekonk has been awarded a MassDevelopment FY22 Technical Assistance Grant for the Former Attleboro Dye Works site, located at 36 Maple Avenue, to conduct a preliminary reuse study for the site to assess potential future uses for the property.

Representatives of the Town of Seekonk and project consultants will be on hand to provide an update on the ongoing remediation efforts and lead a discussion of possible re-use of the property, building on earlier outreach efforts and discussions.
